The review of the *Education Services of Overseas Students (ESOS) Act* will require all institutions registered to teach foreign students to be re-registered under tougher criteria by December 2010.

The tougher rules aim to:

- restore confidence in the quality of Australia's international education industry; and
- protect foreign students from exploitation

This means:

- institutions must show that their main purpose is to provide education; and
- institutions must demonstrate their capacity to provide quality education
